There are 342 students participating in the parish CCD Program. 18 instructors and 7 aides are involved. She also oversees JaM and sacramental preparation. She has gotten positive feedback from these programs. Looking ahead: increase Special Buddies Program for young people with special needs, a preschool CCD program, an effective CCD website. JoAnn also spoke of an interest in getting more family participation in CCD and in the parish, and ongoing training for instructors.
